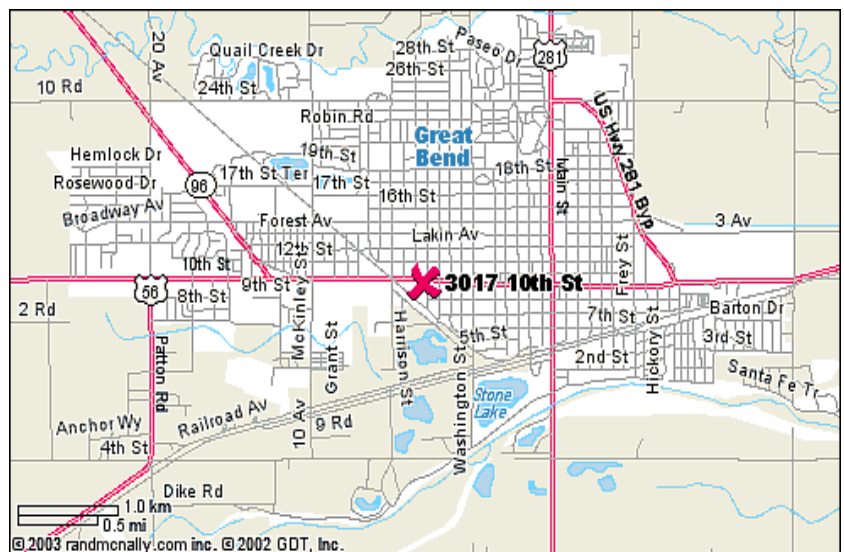

# ABOUT THE WORKSHOPS AND THE PRESENTERS

## *“The Changing World of Addictions”*

8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Thursday, Joel Christiansen, EdS, MEd

This workshop provides an overview on what addiction looks like today and what it may look like in the future with respect to emerging new addictions. Participants will explore what works and doesn't work in prevention, intervention, treatment and recovery, and look at new ways that could work. This training challenges participants to a new way of viewing, thinking and doing with respect to addictions. Presenter offers obstacles that stand in the way of effective treatment and recovery, and looks at ways to overcome them. Participants will also examine ways to respond to the personal, professional and financial strain, stress and wreckage addiction creates and looks at how to build a foundation to achieve an enduring recovery.



**ABOUT THE PRESENTER:** Joel Christiansen is a successful educator, entrepreneur, author and professional speaker who has devoted his life to serving the greater good of others. His two books, *Out of the Ashes: The Resurrection of an Addict* and *Stop Whining and Start Winning: The Power of Life's Choices* have been described as a guide to living a life that reflects happiness and purpose. Joel has been recognized as an Outstanding Young Man in America and an Outstanding Educator in America. During his educational career, Joel was the School Community Intervention and Prevention Program Coordinator for the Lincoln Public Schools. Joel has been straight and sober since September 14, 1981.

## *“Psychological Aspects of the Action and Escape Gambler: Assessment, Personality Types, and Treatment Considerations”* 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. Thursday, Duane Olberding, CADCIH, KCGC

This presentation will fulfill DSM-IV and also Diagnosis and Treatment considerations for the conference. It addresses the comorbidity of pathological gambling and personality disorders and the treatment milieu and strategies that can lead to successful outcomes with these clients. The presentation will address the importance of assessment toward initial creation of the alliance with the therapist; how the initial assessment leads to the correct treatment milieu and thus better treatment outcome; and lastly how to use the assessment toward decreasing resistance to treatment in the pathological gambler which can increase treatment adherence and length.



**ABOUT THE PRESENTER:** Duane Olberding is the Clinical Director of Professional Treatment Services, LLC located in Lawrence, Kansas. He is the past president of the Kansas Coalition on Problem Gambling, past member the Kansas Association of Addiction Professionals Executive Board; and a member to the Kansas Social and Rehabilitative Services Kansas Citizens Committee. Duane's past work experience includes therapy at the Professionals in Crisis program at Menninger Clinic; Clinical Coordinator at the Recovery Center at St. Francis; and adjunct professor at Washburn University.

## *FEATURED CONFERENCE PRESENTER—Dr. David Mee-Lee*

### *“Helping People Change: Motivational Interviewing and Collaborative Care”* 8:30 - 11:30 a.m. Friday

Denial and resistance are expected parts of many individuals' presentation. In the past, helping people change has too often depended on seeing resistance as negative client pathology. Dr. Mee-Lee will describe key concepts about the stages of change and present motivational enhancement therapies to engage the client as an active participant in treatment. Participants will learn to apply ways to better assess people's readiness to change and quickly develop the treatment contract. Attendees will also participate in an active discussion addressing how best to build motivation for change and engage and retain clients in treatment.

### *“Co-Occurring Disorders: Clinical Dilemmas in Assessment and Treatment”* 12:00 - 2:00 p.m. Friday

In the behavioral health field, mental health problems and alcohol or other drug abuse frequently co-occur or are intimately involved in etiology and/or treatment. Because clinicians often lack training in both addiction and mental health treatment, clients with co-occurring psychiatric and addiction illnesses frequently receive inadequate care, caught in the gap between the mental health and addiction treatment systems. This workshop is designed to assist participants with clinical dilemmas in identifying, assessing and treating those with co-occurring psychiatric and addiction illnesses and help them find ways to better integrate services.



**ABOUT THE PRESENTER:** David Mee-Lee, M.D. is a board-certified psychiatrist and is certified by examination of the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM). He is based in Davis, CA and is involved in full-time training and consulting both nationally and internationally. Dr. Mee-Lee is a Senior Fellow for the Co-Occurring Center for Excellence (COCE) for Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) and is a Senior Advisor to the Change Companies. He is Chief Editor of the Revised Second Edition of the ASAM Criteria, ASAM PPC-2R, which includes criteria for co-occurring mental and substance-related disorders. Dr. Mee-Lee has over thirty years experience in treatment and program development for people with co-occurring mental and substance use disorders.
